### **Entry Requirements**

A Level 7 business qualification or a Level 8 qualification in any other discipline or equivalent with relevant work experience. Mature applicants who are over 23 years of age on January 1st (year of entry) may be deemed eligible totake the course depending on their prior learning and work experience, general education standard, motivation and commitment to the course.

### **Eligibility for Funding**

Springboard courses are 100% funded if you are unemployed. For those in employment a student contribution fee of €500 is required at the start of the course.

Returners and employed participants: are required to meet nationality and residency

requirements for Springboard courses. Please see 'Springboard+ Participant Eligibility' at https://springboardcourses.ie/eligibility for more information.

## English Language Requirements

Candidates whose first language is not English may also be required to sit the Dorset College English Competency Test.

### How to Make your Springboard Application

### Documentation/Interview Requirements

Once you make your application you will be required to submit academic documentation and a CV. We may also request you to participate in an informal interview to assess your motivation, commitment and suitability for the course.
